



Controlled Substance Contract

Due to multiple incidents of improper medication use, the following rules will be implemented for all patients in our clinic who use controlled substances, as of 12/12/2012. These medications include (but are not limited to) Vicodin, Lortab, Lorcet, Hydrocodone, Methadone, Xanax, Alprazolam, Clonazepam, and Soma.

1. You may only have one physician prescribing controlled substances. For example, you cannot get Vicodin from one doctor, and Lortab from another. Both have Hydrocodone and are controlled.
2. You may only use one pharmacy for your controlled medications.
3. You may receive controlled medications sooner than one week prior to when you are due for refills.
4. Anyone using these medications is subject to random drug testing with a urine test. If you have any illegal drugs, you will no longer be able to receive controlled medications.
5. If you use controlled medicines chronically, you may be referred to a pain management specialist.

Any inappropriate use will lead to immediate termination of controlled substance prescriptions. We will regularly audit patients using these medications to determine if there are any violations of the above rules.
